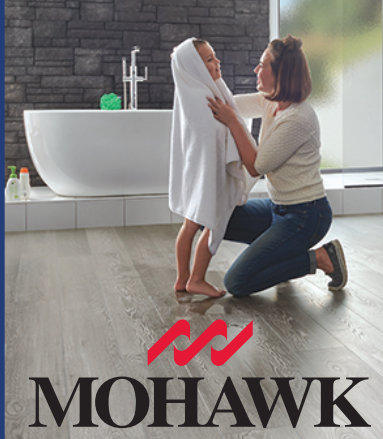

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# SCHOOL DISTRICT POLICIES AND NOTIFICATIONS

## **Nondiscrimination Policy**

It is the policy of the School Board of District 192 that no person shall, on the basis of race, color, national origin, creed, religion, sex, marital status, parental status, sexual orientation, family care leave status, or veteran status with regard to public assistance, age, or disability be excluded from participating in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under any educational program or in employment, promotion, transfer or recruitment, consideration, or selection; whether full-time or part-time under any educational program or activity operated by the district.

As required by Title IX and other state and federal nondiscrimination laws, ISD 192 does not discriminate in employment or in any of its education programs and activities, including admission and employment. ## **Policy Prohibiting Harassment and Violence**

It is the policy of Independent School District 192 to maintain a learning and working environment that is free from harassment and violence. The district prohibits any form of harassment and violence on the basis of race, color, creed, religion, national origin, sex, age, marital status, familial status, status with regard to public assistance, sexual orientation or disability.

It shall be a violation of this policy for any pupil, teacher, administrator or other school personnel of the school district to harass a pupil, teacher, administrator or

other school personnel through conduct or communication or regarding as defined in this policy.

The School District will act to investigate all complaints, either formal or informal, verbal or written, of harassment or violence, and to discipline or take appropriate action against any pupil, teacher, administrator or other school personnel who is found to have violated this policy. ## **Assurance of Compliance Equity Laws**

District 192 complies with all state and federal laws prohibiting discrimination. If you would like to review any of the required laws prohibiting discrimination, please contact your school building office.

## **Protection and Privacy of Pupil Records**

The ISD 192 Student Record Data Privacy Policy, Policy 515, which incorporates state and federal requirements, requires annual notification to parents and students that certain information from student records will be released and made public without the written consent of the parents (or students 18 or older).

In accordance with this policy, District 192 officials may release the following directory information without permission, unless the district has been notified that it should not be released: the student's name, dates of attendance, grade level.

Parents or students 18 or older who do not wish directory information to be released must notify the Superintendent's Office in writing within two weeks of this notice.

Minnesota school districts are required by law to release the names, addresses and home phone numbers of students in grades 11 and 12 to military recruiters if requested.

If the parent or guardian of a student or an eligible student (student who is 18 years of age or older or attending a post-secondary school) objects to the release of this information to military recruiters, they must notify the school administration within two weeks of this notice. When thus notified, that student's records will be marked to indicate that the district should not release this information about the student.

This designation will remain in effect until modified in writing by the student's parent or guardian or the eligible student.

## **Student Photographs & Likenesses**

Likenesses, such as photographs and videos, of students engaging in school activities may be published without permission, unless the district has been notified in writing that they should not be published.

This designation will remain in effect until modified in writing by the student's parent or guardian or the eligible student (18 years of age or older).

## **Publishing Student Work**

The ISD 192 Consent for Publishing Student Work Policy, Policy 1004, requires annual public notice that parents and legal guardians have the right to deny consent to publish their student's work. At any time, parents/guardians may deny consent for publication of student work by notifying the School District in writing that any and all student work should not be disclosed without the prior written consent of the parent. The denial of consent is valid for the student's tenure in that school or until the parents/guardians submit a written notification granting approval to publish student work. School district staff will consult this record prior to publishing student work.

## **Pledge of Allegiance**

The school board recognizes the need to provide instruction in the proper etiquette, display, and respect of the United

States flag. The purpose of this policy is to provide for recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance and instruction in school to help further that end.

Students in this school district shall recite the pledge of allegiance to the flag of the United States of America one or more times each week. The recitation shall be conducted by each individual classroom teacher or the teacher's surrogate, or over a school intercom system by a person designated by the school principal or other person having administrative control over the school.

Any student or teacher may decline to participate in recitation of the pledge of allegiance to the flag. Students must respect the choice not to recite the pledge. Students will be instructed in the proper etiquette toward, correct display of, and respect for the flag in patriotic exercises.

## **Special Education Services Notice**

Farmington Area Public Schools provides students with special needs additional assistance as mandated under the Federal reauthorization of the Individuals with Disabilities Act (IDEA).

Currently, students suspected of having a disability or having difficulty in school can be referred to the Student Assistance Team in each building, by parents, teachers, or administration. The team consists of teachers and the school psychologist who will meet with the parents, other classroom teachers, and specialists to develop interventions to be used in the classroom to help the student. If the student continues to have difficulty and the parent agrees, a number of tests, observations and assessments will be given by special education teachers. If the student's evaluation results meet the criteria set by the Minnesota Department of Education, the student is considered a student in need of special education services. The student can receive help in the form of small group or individualized instruction.

# SCHOOL DISTRICT POLICIES AND NOTIFICATIONS

An Individualized Education Program (IEP) is written to meet the needs of the student. Students who have been identified with a disorder of speech, learning, vision, hearing, physical, developmental problems or a specific condition which may cause difficulties such as Attention Deficit Disorder or Autism are eligible for services.

Early Intervention Services are for eligible infants, toddlers and preschoolers with developmental delays. Parents and family members, doctors, hospital and public health nurses, WIC clinics, and childcare providers can all refer a child for an early intervention evaluation. These services are designed to identify and meet children's needs in five developmental areas: Physical, Cognitive, Communication, Social-Emotional, and Adaptive skills.

Costs for special services are defrayed through federal funds received for special needs students. The school district follows the state and federal guidelines when applying for special education funding. Federal law also provides for additional training of staff to keep them current on the latest advances and techniques for working with children with special needs.

## **Tobacco Free Policy**

Independent School District 192 provides a tobacco-free environment for its students, staff, and citizens. The district's buildings, grounds, and vehicles have been designated as tobacco-free since Aug. 1, 1988.

## **Weapons Policy**

The purpose of this policy is to ensure a safe school environment for students, staff, and the public. Students or any other persons of any age are forbidden to possess, display, store, handle, transit, or use any instrument that is considered a weapon or a "look-alike" weapon in school buildings, on school grounds, at school activities, at bus stops or in school-owned or school-leased vehicles,

or entering upon or departing from school premises, property or events.

## **Pesticide Notice**

A Minnesota state law went into effect in 2000 that requires schools to inform parents and guardians if certain pesticides are applied to school property.

Specifically, this law requires schools that apply these pesticides to maintain an estimated schedule of pesticide applications and to make the schedule available to parents and guardians for review or copying at each school office. State law also requires that you be told that the long-term health effects on children from the application of such pesticides or the class of chemicals to which they belong may not be fully understood.

## **Indoor Air Quality Management Plan**

District 192 has implemented an IAQ Management Plan that will help monitor and improve the quality of air in school buildings. The objectives of the IAQ Management Plan are: 1) reduce the levels of indoor air pollutants through preventive measures such as routine maintenance activities, periodic building evaluations and inspections, and IAQ-specific policies; 2) provide and maintain adequate air exchanges by repairing and maintaining ventilation equipment, which will promote a comfortable and healthful learning and working environment, and; 3) respond to IAQ-related concerns and problems in a thorough and prompt manner, and to effectively communicate the progress of investigations and their resolutions to all interested parties. ## **Semi-annual Asbestos Notification**

District 192 continues its ongoing efforts to manage and control asbestos-containing materials within the four buildings that still contain asbestos to maintain a safe and healthy environment for students, employees and other occupants.

Periodic surveillance will be conducted at Tiger Legacy and Learning Center, Farmington Elementary School and Boeckman Middle School. ## **Lead in Water Notification**

Farmington Area Public Schools is committed to providing a safe working and learning environment for employees and students. In accordance with Minnesota Statute 121A.335, the Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) and the Minnesota Department of Education (MDE), the Farmington Area Public Schools has conducted, and continues to conduct, Lead in Drinking Water testing per the Minnesota Department of Health's "Reducing Lead in Drinking Water: A Technical Guidance for Minnesota's School and Child Care Facilities" recommendations.

Farmington Area Public Schools last sampled all water sources in the 2021-22 school year. The next five-year cycle evaluation is scheduled for the 2026-2027 school year. ## **Radon Testing Notification**

Farmington Area Public Schools contracts with the Institute for Environmental Assessment (IEA) to conduct radon testing in all occupied district buildings every 5 years as recommended by the Minnesota Department of Health and the Environmental Protection Agency.

Farmington Area Public Schools last conducted a long-term monitoring test in the 2021-22 school year. All tested sites registered less than the MDH and EPA annual average threshold. The next five-year cycle evaluation is scheduled for the 2026-2027 school year. ## **Student Surveys**

ISD 192 may utilize surveys to gather student opinions and information about students, as outlined in Policy 520. Parents will be given direct, timely notice when their students are scheduled to participate in a student survey, the opportunity to review the survey and to opt their students out of participating in the survey.
